

## TYPICAL WORK DUTIES OF A SYSTEM OPERATOR



- 1. Check High Pressure Hoses/Guns/Wands/tips for damage and Report Tears, leaks or any other issues to a supervisor.
- 2. Check belts for wear or slippage.
- 3. Check to insure that the area around the machine is clear of debris, flammable liquids, and other items That could ignite. Maintain a 5 ft clearance around the unit for proper airflow.

DO NOT use the machine until repairs are made.

- CHECK FLUID LEVELS Pump Oil Water tank Detergents
  - 1. Use only 30Wt Non Detergent Oil in Pump change every 500 hours
  - 2. Do not put grease in the Zerk fitting on the Electric Motor
  - 3. Review SDS on all Detergents before handling the product or using the product.

## • VISUALLY OBSERVE THE MACHINE IN USE.

- 1. Reports any abnormal issues observed to a supervisor.
- 2. The machine is designed to run smooth, and without vibration. Report any issue seen to a supervisor.
- 3. The Burner is designed for good combustion, there should be no smoke, no flame mushroom from Underneath the burner area. Do not place fans around the machine area that could distort the burner operation.
- Listen Stop the machine and Report any noise that is uncommon or that you do not usually hear or that you are concerned with. Do not use the machine until repairs are made that alleviate the noise concerns.

## WARNINGS.

DO NOT ALLOW THE MACHINE TO FREEZE.

DO NOT PLAY WITH THE TRIGGER GUN WITH REPEATED PULLS And RELEASES DO NOT WASH YOUR BOOTS - SHOES OR POINT THE HIGH PRESSURE SPRAY AT ANY OTHER INDIVIDUAL. HIGH PRESSURE SPRAY WILL PENETRATE THE SKIN AND CAUSE SERIOUS INJURY. DO NOT USE THIS MACHINE UNLESS YOU HAVE READ AND FULLY UNDERSTAND THE CONTENT PROVIDED IN THE OPERATORS MANUAL PROVIDED WITH THIS UNIT.
